

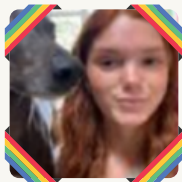

MESSAGE FROM MRS PECK

Welcome back! Last half term, the children did a good job of settling in and adjusting to the challenges and expectations of Year 5. Our classroom routines are now running smoothly and it has been great to see children working with increasing independence, productivity and improved outcomes. This half term, we will continue to embed these learning attitudes and expectations as we cover more of the curriculum.

SCIENCE

In Science, we will continue our focus on Properties and Changes of Materials before moving onto learning about the life cycles of a range of plants and animals.

HISTORY

In History, we will be learning about the lives and achievements of the Ancient Greeks. We will discover how this ancient civilisation has impacted our lives today.

MATHS

In maths, we will be focusing on multiplication, division and fractions. We will continue our weekly arithmetic work and consolidate learning from last half term.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be celebrating differences and learning about other cultures. We will continue to develop our understanding of how to keep safe online.

ART

In Art, we will focus on self-portraits and the work of Giuseppe Arcimboldo. We will analyse and critique famous self-portraits to gain an understanding of techniques, styles and the concept of self-representation.

ENGLISH

In English, we will continue to develop our knowledge and understanding of grammar, punctuation and sentence structures through our focus on character descriptions and newspaper reports. Reading and spelling are taught daily.

RE

In RE, we will focus on the religion of Islam. We will learn about Muslim beliefs and how these affect and impact the daily lives of individuals.

PE

In PE, we will be focusing on dance and gymnastics. We will be learning about dynamics and choreography, as well as building control and quality into our performances.

COMPUTING

In computing, we will learning how to be game creators. We will research a range of games, before designing, creating, evaluating and improving our own.

MUSIC

In music, we will be comparing and contrasting one song sung by different artists. We will learn to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song.

FRENCH

In French, pupils will learn the transactional language required in a tea room. The children will learn how to ask for a range of foods and drinks.
