

Year 3 Newsletter



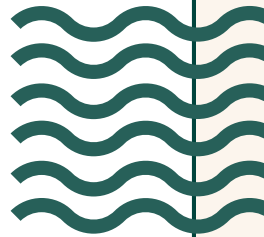
Welcome back!

Maths

In maths we will be continuing to develop our knowledge on place value, addition and subtraction as well as multiplication and division.

Science

In science this half term we will be starting a new topic We will be focusing on rocks, how they are formed, their physical properties and how they are formed.

Art

History
