The Curriculum

ENGLISH

This half term, we are reading 'Pig Heart Boy' by Malorie Blackman. We will explore the model text, 'Why Animal Organs Should be used to Save Human Lives' before writing our own persuasive speeches.

MATHS

In maths, our units are statistics, geometry (including angles, nets and circles) and position and direction (including coordinates, translation and reflection).

SCIENCE

Our unit this half term is 'Evolution and Inheritance'. We will be learning about living things and their offspring and about how plants and animals have adapted to their environment. We will also be conducting an experiment to investigate how Darwin's theory of evolution works.

FOUNDATION SUBJECTS

In **art**, our unit is 'Graffiti Art: In the Style of Banksy'. The children will be exploring the work of Banksy and local graffiti artist, Andy Pea, before creating their own art work.

In **PSHE**, we will be exploring the consequences in regards to the choices we make regarding our health, both emotionally and physically.

In **history**, we will be learning about Humber fishing, including Hull Port and the impact of the Second World War. We will also be studying the Triple Trawler Tragedy.

In **RE**, we will be continuing to learn about the Christian creation story and making comparisons to other theories.

In **computing**, we will be coding.

In **French**, our unit is, 'At School' and we will be learning the names of the different subjects and how to share our opinions of them.

In **music**, our unit is 'You've Got a Friend'.

In **PE**, we will be developing our skills in target dodgeball and outdoor and adventurous activities.

PE days will continue to be on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
